2. We had Ged Burdon Principal Port Health Officer for Southampton who had been invited to give us a talk on the work of his dept in the Docks he covered several topics such as Cruise Liner safety and food Hygiene also noise nuisance from the Container movements 24/7. His Dept is responsible for the Solent & Isle of Wight and waterways up to the river Test he stated that although there were problems for the area such as noise the Port is vital to the local economy and said any concerns we had we could ring him and he would do his best to solve them, this was a very interesting talk Ged did answer questions from the meeting. Paul Hennessey thanked him for his talk on behalf of the association.
3. Minutes of the Meeting of 18<sup>th</sup> September 2008; were read and agreed.
4. Matters Arising; There was 1 matter arising Parmjit Thiara said the Blinds were available for Rozel Court but there were no funds to fit them she was still trying to find some.
5. Treasurers Report; Gary Waters gave the report we are good shape the only concern was the cost of Printing Cartridges.
6. Five Acres; Paul Hennessey gave a report back from the Oasis Lordshill Academy Meeting and explained to the meeting the 2 proposals. The Academy has also been speaking to the Cricket/Rugby Clubs and Cedar PH School.
7. 40 Year Celebration; Paul Hennessey told the meeting we had applied for Grant of nearly £2000 to help fund the event and said we hope to have a Climbing Wall operated by qualified operators. It is hoped to create a 6ftx6ft Quilt made by people from the Estate we will be seeking volunteers to take part.
8. Open Forum; Lisa White attended the meeting with her son's Social Worker to explain the problems of A.D.H.D. which her son suffers from, he has as she knew, been causing problems in the area, she is going through a course of training to cope with his illness and asked the meeting to contact her or knock her door rather than tell her son Ricky off because he does not respond like

other children. The Chairman thanked Lisa for coming to the meeting and explaining her son's situation. The meeting gave her their support and said they would cooperate with her wishes. Some Residents/Tenants were very concerned that School children from the Lords' hill Academy have been crossing the Main road halfway down Brownhill Way to get to the Academy Site at the old Oakland's Site the Safety Fence has been damaged by them doing this. There was also a complaint of Large Vans being parked causing driving Obstruction/Hazzards in Boniface Crescent and some side roads. Parmjit Thiara told the meeting the Council Policy on parking and said perhaps the PCSOs could have a word if it is reported to them although there are no restrictions to stop this if they are legally parked it was a difficult problem and normally common sense will prevail.

9. Free Draw; The Draw took place and several lucky winners took their prizes.
10. Paul thanked everybody for their attendance wished them a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year and told them the date of the next was on 22 January at 7pm in Rozel Court.
