In the last issue we gave a list of "helpful" hints about mobile phone uses. We have discovered that most of these are not viable.

112 will work in some cases to get local emergency connection.

*4720# will give increased battery power.

Disabling the phone through the 15 number code is limited and you are better contacting the service provider with your details.

It is unlikely that the use of a mobile phone to unlock your car doors will work as the system of transmission is not compatible.

Reversing the ATM number at a "Hole in the wall" to alert police is not viable (consider reversing 2002!). This option was considered in the USA but found to be untenable.
